#### SPECIFICATIONS FOR TOPOGRAPHICAL SURVEY WORK

The selected road section for the survey is demarcated in the attached map (B214 road from P1 to P2). The coordinates of the reference locations are as follows.

The selected cross drainage structures and lead-away canals/drains for the survey are demarcated in the attached map.

The following details are to be obtained at the survey work.

#### Topo plan

- A 5m passage on either side from the road edge is required to be shown on a plat plan, including details of the road, roadside drains, pavement, boundary walls, existing buildings, utility posts, and any other significant features.
- A 3m passage on either side from the banks of lead-away canals of existing culverts, up to the outlet (main stream or marshland), is required to be shown on a flat plan, including details of bank type, boundary walls, existing buildings, utility posts, and any other significant features.

#### Longitudinal sections

- The Longitudinal Sections (LS) of the road sections demarcated in the attached map should be obtained along the centreline.
- The Longitudinal Sections (LS) of the lead-away canals/ drains demarcated in the attached map should be obtained along the centreline.
- Levels want to be taken at 10m intervals.

#### **Cross sections**

- Cross Sections (CS) of road sections are required to be obtained at 30m intervals.
- Levels of the cross-section are to be taken up to 5m on either side from the road edge covering the roadside drain information (if exists)

- All important details such as the width & depth of the drain, bed level of the drain, drain type, etc. should be indicated clearly in roadside drains.
- Cross Sections (CS) of lead away canals/ drains are required to be obtained at 30m intervals.

#### Crossing drainage structures survey

- All existing bridges and culverts are required to be surveyed within the road section demarcated in the attached map
- The dimensions such as length (L), width (W), height (H), inverts (Inv1 & Inv2) and road top levels (P1, P2 & P3) as shown in figure-2 of culverts, bridges and any other structures across the selected drainage paths should be taken with an accuracy of (+ or -) 5 mm.




Figure 1: Sketch of a typical culvert

 Lead in and Lead away canal details of culverts, such as cross section, canal type, want to be obtained.

### Flood hearing survey

A Flood hearing survey is conducted to acquire historical inundation data of the study area, crucial for the calibration process of rainfall runoff and inundation models. The required inundation information can be gleaned by actively engaging nearby residents. The following information is required to be collected during this survey.

• Inundated depth (depth can be converted to level during the survey) of the known locations such as culverts, bridges, boundary wall, electricity posts, etc.

- The corresponding depth must refer to known recent rainfall events. June 2024 and October 2024 events are preferred to obtain the inundation information.
- Inundated extent (up to which location got inundated) of the road for the same events.

#### Horizontal control

- Entire survey shall be connected to the National Grid System (SLD-99) of the Survey Department, Sri Lanka.
- The Contractor shall run the necessary control traverses in and around the entire survey area to ensure the required accuracy for the survey.

#### FOR CONTROL TRAVERSES

- AZIMUTH check should be made for every 25 lines.
- AZIMUTH closure at azimuth check point should not exceed 10" per station or  $\sqrt{80}$ " N (N= number of lines)
- Position closure 0.8\sqrt{D} meters, where D is the total length in Km.

#### Vertical control

- Temporary Bench Marks with respect to the mean sea level (MSL) datum shall be established along the survey route approximately 500m apart.
- All benchmarks shall be established with a 10mm diameter steel pin embedded in concrete
  and fixed onto the permanent features and so positioned to be readily accessible but clear of
  vehicular traffic or waterlogged areas.
- It shall be the contractor's responsibility to establish temporary benchmarks and hand over to SLLDC in writing the location and value of the benchmark after completion of work.
- The Contractor should establish vertical control points around the survey area. The Contractor shall also establish additional TBM required for his work. Allowable error of the detail levelling should not exceed + or  $-24\sqrt{k}$  mm where k is the distance between bench marks measured along levelling route in km.
